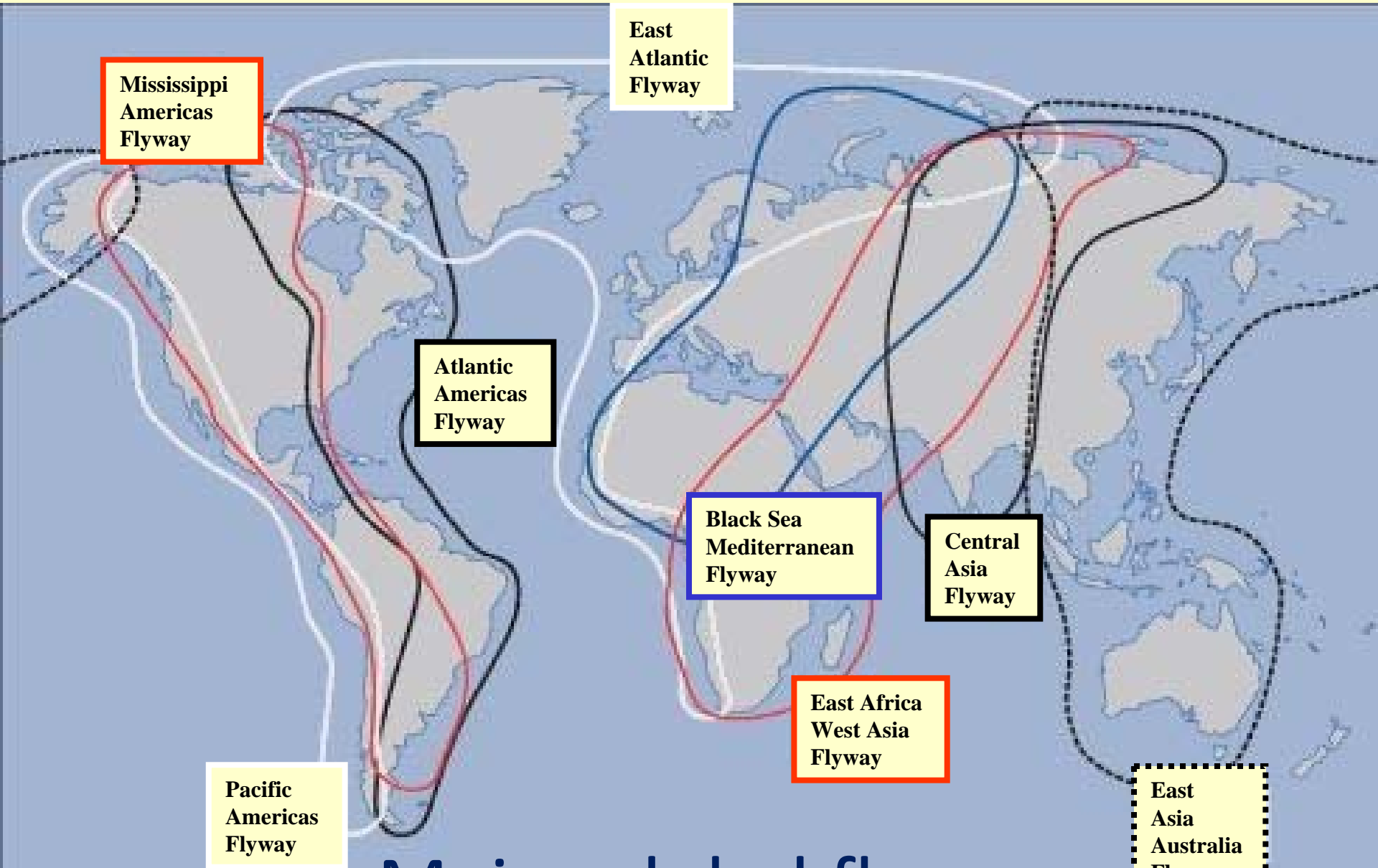

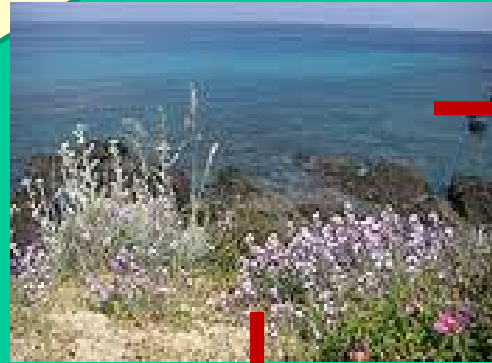

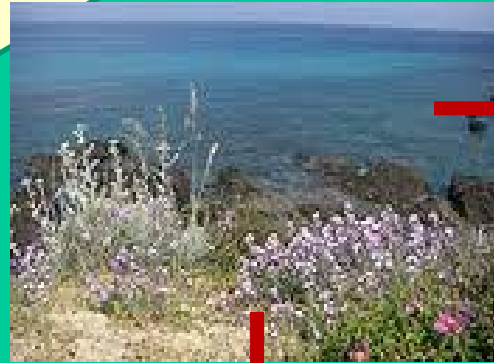

Major global flyways



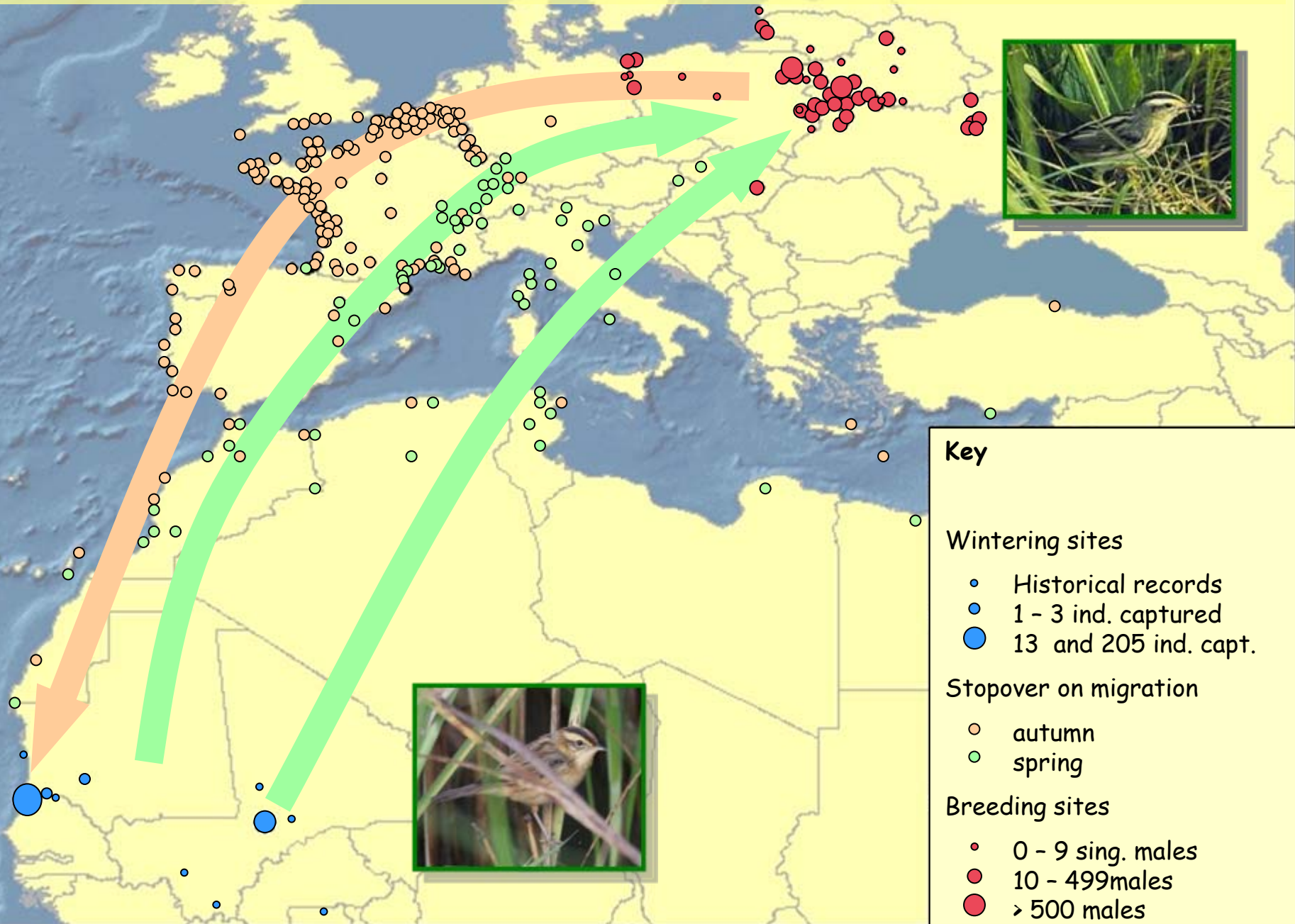


Migrants use a chain of sites and habitats along the flyway
